Last fall while attending a workshop with RI Division of State Purchases and RI PTAC, Michelle recognized that the State had added a new contract solicitation vehicle called "Continuous Recruit-

ment" to the A/E Master Price agreement. "Continuous recruitment" allows vendors at certain dates during the active performance period of the MPA, to submit a proposal response for review. A vendor must use continuously posted evaluation criteria for a particular MPA, and if qualified, be added to the list of approved vendors.

Michelle did just that, was added to the list of approved vendors and took off winning contracts throughout the state municipal school systems. She indicated that, "The contracts varied in value but it is meaningful that we are able to develop lasting relationships in a market that we serve, that will continue after the project is done".

Representative from Boeing, Sikorsky/Lockheed Martin, UTC Aerospace, Raytheon IDS and Draper Lab were also in attendance at the out-reach event and met with small business owners interested in becoming part of the NASA supply chain. PTAC staff was provided with a list of existing NASA contract holders specific to each NASA location with information about each contract.

NASA utilizes contractors for administrative services, facilities maintenance, engineering services, accounting/financial/business services, protective services, office supplies, and IT. DoD Procurement Instrument Identification (PIID) Change

In order to standardize procurement transactions across the federal government, the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Subpart 4.16, Unique Procurement Instrument Identifiers (PIID) has been amended to implement a uniform award identification system referred to as the Procurement Instrument Identification (PIID).

For DLA the new structure will continue to require use of Activity Address Codes (AACs) as the unique identifier for contracting offices, the current fiscal year, instrument type and a four-character serial number. Existing contract, purchase order, delivery order numbers will not change. **Beginning October 1, 2016 manual purchase order numbers will change from "m" to "p" in the 9th position.** Automated purchase orders will continue to use a "V" in the 9th position.
